

PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

HAZARDS TO HUMANS AND DOMESTIC ANIMALS

FIRST AID

If In Eyes	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes.• Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye.• Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
If On Skin or Clothing	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Take off contaminated clothing.• Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes.• Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor, or going for treatment.

Treats: 3,500 Gallons every other week for up to 18 months
5,000 Gallons every other week for up to 13 months
7,500 Gallons every other week for up to 8 months

**DOSAGE
CUP ENCLOSED**

Use MICROBE-LIFT/BMC to prevent mosquitoes from breeding in listed treatment areas and other areas where standing water accumulates.

Use dosage cup provided. Add MICROBE-LIFT/BMC directly to the water to be treated. Use 2.5ml per 1,000 gallons of water (5ml per 2,000 gallons of water) every other week. Treat weekly if necessary.
